UNBELIEVABLE LOVE

The Gospel passage proclaimed on this Sunday goes under several headings. It is known as "The Prodigal Son", "The Forgiving Father" and "The Gospel within the Gospel". It is one of the best known and most popular readings. Everyone warms up to it.

The central character is not one of the two sons but the father. He appears in the first verse of the parable and is still there at the last. In between he is shown in relationship with his two sons. The first is more than rude. He goes to his father and demands that he get his share of the inheritance. He finds waiting until his father dies too long so he lets him know that his main interest in Dad is his wealth, here and now! Dad loves the young man so much he gives in and hands over a third of all his property. Off the man goes and squanders all.

When things get really bad he comes home, humbled and repentant. His father receives him with open arms and heart. He does not tell him off nor even scold him. He is restored to full family circle.



The older brother gets angry at his father's good treatment of his brother, refuses to join in the celebrations, repudiates his father, brings up a list of his grievances against him, sees himself as a slave to the family and the list could go on.

The father remains calm. He ignores the insults and pours out love on his two sons. His love for them knows no bounds. All of this is meant to indicate to us how God our Father treats us with infinite love even when we sin, insult and even abandon him.
